With Uwatec's newly updated software, users can now send their dive profiles for Project Dive Exploration directly from *SmartTrak*. Follow the directions below for creating and exporting the DL7 file.

## How to send your dive profiles to DAN: Export dive profiles to a DL7 file:

Uwatec users can now export their dives in the DAN (Divers Alert Network) DL7 Level 3 format. The DL7 Level 3 format includes the diver's personal information and detailed description of the dive.

1. **Download** data from the dive computer using Uwatec *SmartTrak*

### 2. Program Options

The Options/Program Options window allows you to change several settings; One of the options is to **set the user name and other personal information for DL7 level 3 format.**

Click on the "Details" button, in the User Name frame, for the "User Information" form.

Complete the information in the Name, Details, Address, Phone and Notes tab information (“Last name”, “First name”, “Date of birth”, “Phone” and “e-mail address” information are mandatory and must be filled in).

**Note: Obtain your DiverID number by enrolling for PDE on the DAN website.**

When completed, click the “OK” button”.

3. Select a dive, open the Dives/Edit window, and choose the DAN tab.

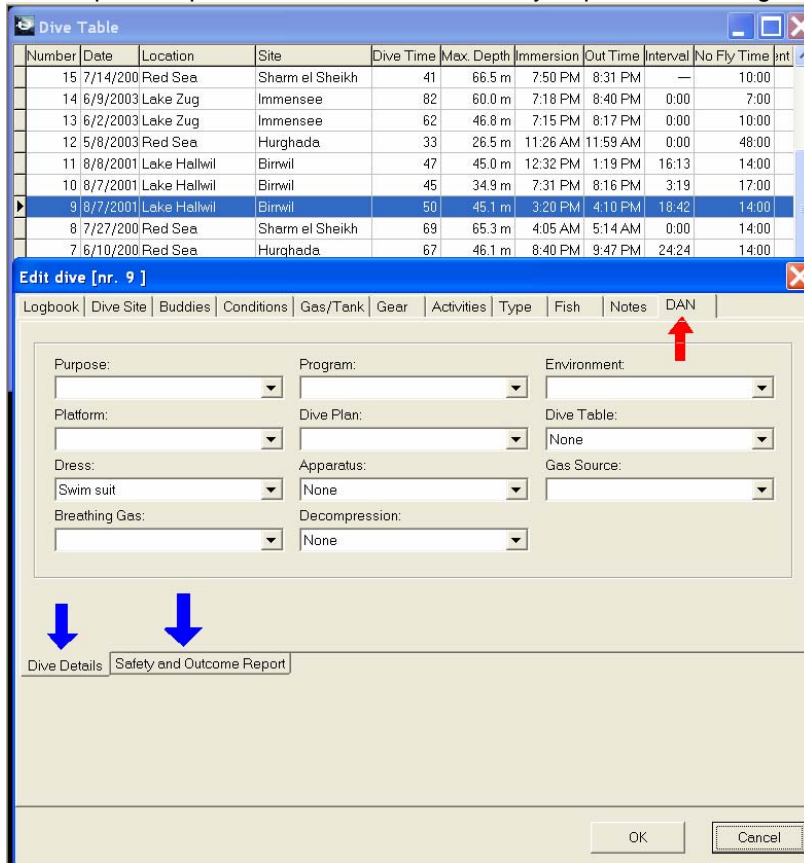

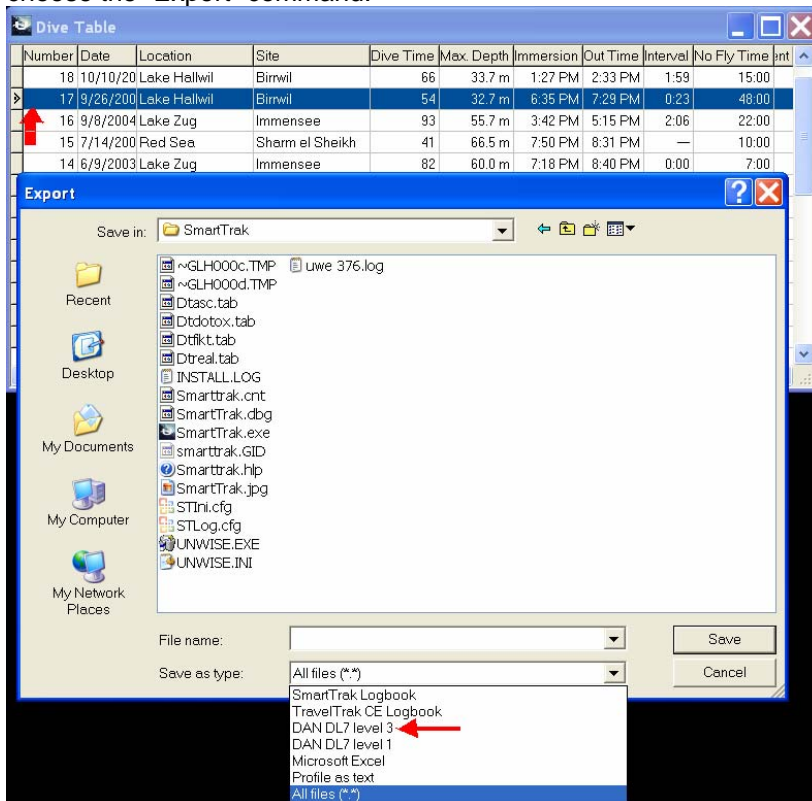

- Complete the “Dive Details” and “Safety and Outcome Report” under the DAN tab; Click OK. Repeat steps 3 and 4 for each dive that you plan on sending to DAN.



- Select one dive or multiple dives in the logbook that you would like to export, and then choose the “Export” command:



Select to save as file type “DAN DL7 level 3” and create a file name (we suggest naming the file the date that you created it. Example: May16\_2006), click “save”. (Note the location this file is saved to. It may be saved in the SmartTrak directory or in a folder called My Logbooks in your My Documents folder.) The dives are now exported in DL7 format (it will be a file with a .zxl extension).

6. SEND DATA TO DAN. To send your data to DAN, generate an email addressed to [dasdata@dan.duke.edu](mailto:dasdata@dan.duke.edu) and attach the file you just exported. It should have a .zxl extension. Example: May16\_2006.zxl.
7. **Complete 48-hour Report.** Don't forget to submit a 48-hour Report in order to complete the data. Your dive profiles will not be useable unless you complete the 48-hour report. The 48-hour report form can be filled out or downloaded from the DAN website.
